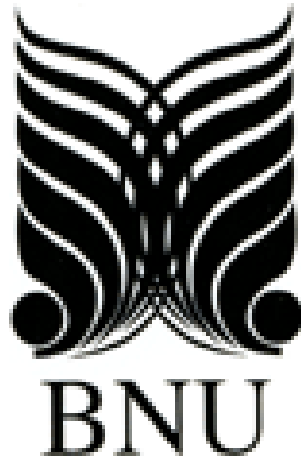

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Declaration by the Parent / Guardian

I declare that in the event of admission of my Son / Daughter to the University.

1. I Father / Guardian will consider myself responsible for the payment of the University fee and any other dues.
2. I will also be responsible for marking up any loss / damage caused by the applicant to the University building and facilities during the course of his / her stay in the University.
3. If, during the course of his/her studies the applicant takes part in the political activity or become a member of a political or student organization, I will be responsible for that, and affirm that the Vice Chancellor / Registrar will be within his rights to strike off the applicant's name from the roll of the University.
4. I affirm that the Vice Chancellor / Registrar can debar the student from attending the University.
5. The Vice Chancellor / Registrar is authorized to strike off a student's name from the University Roll as a punishment for infringement of the University's Rules and Regulations.
6. If, the documents submitted by the my son / daughter for admission are proved incorrect at any stage or found to be fake or to contain an incorrect statement or error which may affect the merit, I will be held responsible and the University will have the authority to cancel his / her admission at any stage and undertake disciplinary action against him / her.
7. I undertake that in case my son / daughter defaults on attendance requirement (maximum 75 percent) he / she would be barred from the University examination and if he / she default on fee payment by the due date he / she would be suspended from the University bearing full responsibility for the consequences. In such cases neither myself nor anyone else would petition the University for condonement.

Instruction & Declaration

1. The completed application form with the required supporting documents i.e. attested photocopies of previous results, four photographs and a non-refundable application processing fee of Rs.500/= should reach the Admission Office BNU by the notified date. Applicants are advised to ensure that the application is complete in all respects.
2. Candidates may apply for provisional admission if they have completed their courses, and are awaiting their results. Applicants who are provisionally admitted must make sure that their results are received in the Admission Office by the specified date.
3. Admission will be subject to an undertaking by the student and his/her parents/guardian to abide by the rules and regulations framed by the University from time to time.
4. All admissions are on merit and there are no reserved seats for any group or individuals.
5. The same academic criteria of eligibility apply to overseas applicants. These applicants are also governed by relevant instructions and guidelines issued by the Federal Government.
6. The selected applicants will be required to complete all the admission formalities by the specified date failing which the offer of admission will be withdrawn.
7. The University reserves the right to cancel the admission of a student involved in any undesirable or illegal activity. Further, if at any stage it is proved that a student has submitted false information/documents, the admission will be cancelled forthwith and the student expelled from the University.
8. Transfer students should submit applications at least 4 weeks before the commencement of the semester concerned. Transfer of Credits may be considered towards the fulfillment of the requirements for a degree after an evaluation by the University Equivalence Committee.
9. A student may add or drop courses only with the approval of the Dean or incharge faculty member in conformity with the prescribed procedure and time limits.
10. Students may also register on line, by visiting the BNU web-site www.bnu.edu.pk. To initiate the admission procedure students registering on-line are required to send a Rs. 500/- Bank Draft / Pay Order in favour of Beaconhouse National University to:

Admission Criteria:

The Beaconhouse National University admits students annually in August, the schedule is detailed in the BNU Academic Calendar.

Students awaiting their FA/FSc/A-Level/, BA/BSc. results may apply for admission. Selected candidates will be granted provisional admission only, which may be regularized after they have been declared successful and meet the admission requirements of BNU.

BA/BSc. (Hons) Programmes

- (i) To be eligible for admission to undergraduate programmes, a candidate must satisfy any one of the following requirements:
- FA/FSc with at least 2nd division (i.e. 495 marks).
 - O levels (in at least 5 subjects) and 3 A levels with at least an average of C grade.
 - High School Diploma result with at least 2.5 CGPA and equivalence certificate from IBCC.
 - For A-Level (3 A level subjects), Advanced Subsidiary will not be taken into account.
- (ii) Admission of students whose academic and other qualifications are lower than those prescribed in (i) above, would not be considered for admission.
- (iii) Student terminated from one school on the basis of poor academic performance or on disciplinary ground will not be eligible to seek admission in any other school of BNU.

In addition, students applying to BNU will be expected to take a written (English) test followed by an interview for the candidates short listed after the written test.

Students applying for admission to the Schools of Visual Arts or Architecture and Design will be required to take a 4 hour Drawing Test followed by an interview for short listed candidates.

Candidates with work experience in communication/media/performance related work will be given preference at the Departments of Theatre, TV and Film Studies and Journalism. Evidence of work such as published material or portfolio of work will be required for short listed candidates.

All other schools require mandatory written/aptitude tests to be taken on dates specified by the University.

MA/M Sc Programmes

To be eligible for placement in the post graduate programmes at the Beaconhouse National University, a candidate should hold a Bachelor's degree in the Humanities or Sciences from a recognized foreign or local education system with placement in the second division.

A person with a Master's or professional degree from a recognized institute of higher learning is also eligible for admission to post graduate programmes. The candidate may be awarded Advanced Standing or be given credit for courses already covered. BNU will provide individual academic advisory counselling to such students. The advisor will review the past academic work and present a recommendation to the Dean/Chairperson of the concerned School.
