INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Test will be of total 100 marks. There will be three objective sections, which will judge candidates on their quantitative skills, verbal reasoning and general knowledge, and one subjective section, which will judge candidates on their writing skills.
2. Candidates will be given maximum of 2 hours to complete the test.
3. Candidates can bring scientific calculators to the test. However, use of any other digital/data storage device (e.g. financial calculators, mobile phones etc.) is strictly prohibited.
4. Candidates are required to bring their own stationary items to the test (like calculator, pen, pencil, rubber etc.). Borrowing and lending of any sort is not allowed during test.
5. Candidates are required to mark their answers in the answer grid/answer sheet provided at the end of the exam. Any questions marked/solved outside the answer grid will not guarantee any credit.

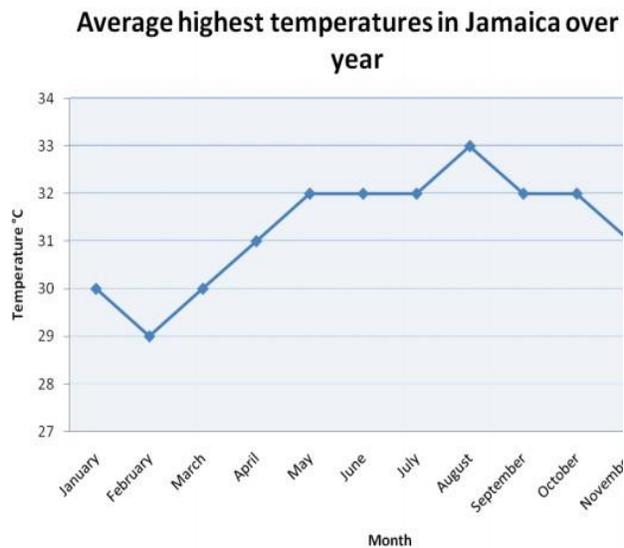
SECTION 1: QUANTITATIVE¹

their mortality rate should decline rapidly if such boat paints are banned.
